

DR. GODFREY GAISIE

Guest of Honour – Adisadel College 105th Speech Day Celebration

Dr. Gaisie is a member of the 1965 year group. He was in Elliott House, and during his 6th form years was a key member of the sprint relay team that won a 2nd place at the National Collegiate Track Meet at Accra.

From Adisadel, he went on to the University of Ghana Medical School, and graduated as a physician in 1972. After his internship and National Service he proceeded to the USA in 1975.

In the USA, he trained as a pediatrician at the Howard University Hospital, and subsequently trained in Radiology at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center, and subspecialized in Pediatric Radiology at The Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh.

He currently works at the Akron Children's Hospital, Ohio, where at one time he was the Chairman of Radiology from 1991 to 2005. He is also currently Professor of Radiology at the Northeast Ohio Medical University.

Dr. Gaisie, together with 2 other members of the 1965 year group, Mr. Robert Baafi and Dr. Albert Richardson explored, and solicited members of the year group towards the implementation of a legacy project for the year group's 50th anniversary after graduation from the school.

The project is a 40 seat Computer Lab consisting of state of the art computer equipment to give students the basic training in computer education, and for those with additional interest, advanced training in Information Technology.
